THE INSTITUTE OF HISTORY “ALI HADRI”-PRISHTINA

The Institute of History “Ali Hadri” in Prishtina, in cooperation with the Institute of Albanology in Prishtina, the Institute of History in Tirana, and the Institute of the Cultural Heritage of Albanians in Skopje, will organize the Scientific Conference: “*Genocide against Albanians during the XIX-XX centuries*”. Researchers are welcomed to present and elaborate their views and scientific research within the broad themes set by the Organizing Council.

The conference will be held on April 8, 2022, and will provide an opportunity to interested scholars to present their work, which will be published within the framework of Conference proceedings. The papers should be submitted for publication no later than June 2023.

The broad themes set up by the Organizing Council may include, but not limited to:

1. The International legal acts of Genocide;
2. Serbian projects against Albanians during the XIX – XX centuries;
3. The violence, terror and violent displacement of Albanians from the north-eastern territories of the vilayet of Kosovo (1804-1878);
4. The Serbian pressure to assimilation of the Orthodox Albanians in Kosovo (1878-1912);
5. The violence and terror against Albanians in Kosovo and other Albanian areas during the Balkan Wars (1912-1913) and the First World War (1914-1918);
6. Emigration, Agrarian Reform and Colonization (1918-1941);
7. Crimes, massacres, and imprisonments of Albanians by the Yugoslav and Bulgarian communists, during and at the end of the Second World War;
8. Trials against Albanians since the promulgation of the Cominform Resolution (July 1948) to the fall of communism and the displacement to Turkey;
9. Violence, terror and prosecutions against Albanians during the years 1990-1997;
10. Murders and massacres during the 1998/99 War in Kosovo and other Albanian areas;
11. Destruction of cultural, economic, social, scientific, educational and health

- institutions of Kosovo;
12. The Serbian ecclesiastical policy towards Albanians in Kosovo;
 13. The stance of current Serbian policy towards the phenomenon of Genocide and its features;
 14. The stance of Great Powers and international organizations towards acts of Genocide against Albanians.
